**GRS Cooperative School District Holds Public Forums
to Present Building Designs and Costs**

Mark your calendars! The Gorham Randolph Shelburne Cooperative School Building Committee and Board invite all citizens of the District to a series of public meetings. According to Ben Mayerson, Chair of the Committee, “For the past 18 months we have worked together to identify and solve the problems at the Gorham Middle High and Edward Fenn Elementary School. We have a good and balanced design solution for the voters to consider at the upcoming March 21 District meeting.”

The forums will be held on the following dates: Wednesday, February 7, at 7 pm at the Randolph Town Hall; Thursday, February 8, at 7pm at the Shelburne Town Hall; and Saturday, February 10 at 9:30am at the GMHS music room. Each forum will last about 60 to 90 minutes. Refreshments will be served.

The Committee and Board will review the areas of concerns at both schools, present the design plans for the renovations and additions, and discuss the tax rates and bond warrant articles that will be considered at the District meeting in March. “We hope that voters will come to one or several of these forums”, says Jo Carpenter, Chair of the School Board. “We’ve worked very hard to bring in the best project at the best price. The Board and Committee will continue to make every effort to reach the public, in order to give them the tools necessary to come to an informed decision regarding the project.”
