GRS School Board Schedules Three Public Forums

The Gorham Randolph Shelburne Cooperative School Board announces three consecutive nights of public forums, to discuss the bonding proposals that will be considered at the District meeting in March 2008.

The first forum will be on Tuesday, January 22, 2008, at the Shelburne Town Hall. The next night, Wednesday, January 23, a forum will be held in the GMHS Music Room. The third forum will be on Thursday, January 24, at the Randolph Fire Station. All forums will begin at 7pm. "Citizens of the three towns are invited to attend any or all of the forums", says Paul Bousquet, Superintendent of SAU20. "The Board has moved ahead from last year's meeting, and is bringing forth two proposals, that not only reflect the voice of the people, but offers a phased solution to the many safety and accreditation issues that must be addressed in the Middle High School and the Edward Fenn Elementary School."

Members of the GRS School Board, as well as Administration will be attending the forums to facilitate the discussion. "We hope the citizens of the Cooperative make an effort to attend these forums, so that they can make an informed decision at the District meeting, says Jo Carpenter, Chair of the GRS Board. "In an effort to include even more voters in the process, the Board has moved the annual School District meeting to Saturday, March 8, 2008, at 10:00 am." Childcare will be available.
