GRS Cooperative School Board Needs to Hear Your Opinions

The GRS School Board has hired KD Paine of Berlin to write, compile, and analyze a survey. “It will be arriving in the mail boxes of all the Gorham, Randolph, and Shelburne voters very shortly”, according to Jo Carpenter, Chair of the GRS School Board. “After the recent March District meeting, the board decided we needed professional help asking the voters what they wanted before we move forward with any major decisions pertaining to the Gorham Middle High School and Edward Fenn Elementary School.”

The anonymous survey will take about 10 minutes to complete, and comes with a postage paid return envelope. The deadline to complete the survey is June 1st. Once KD Paine receives the surveys, the results will be tabulated and a report will be sent back to the board. Results will also be available to the public through the SAU 20 office and will be posted on the SAU20 website.

“We know this issue is of great concern to the taxpayers of the three member towns”, says Carpenter. “That’s why we need to hear from everyone”.

Topics on the survey will include whether the District should move forward with a new building plan, repairs and renovations, tuition students to Berlin, or attempt to form an expanded cooperative school district with Berlin or another town.
