- I. Call to Order: Jo Carpenter called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

- VI. Other: Paul Bousquet shared that the SAU has received a bid for a 3-year lease on copier equipment. Kathleen Kelley asked for an update of the building project issues. Paul Bousquet shared that the staging is up on the chimneys; widows are ordered from Portland Glass; one of the new buses has arrived; the boiler and fire alarm will be taken care of before school starts; and the Board should have all received copies of the property letter.
