The Errol Consolidated School is a small elementary/middle public school located in Northern New Hampshire.

Our multi-age classrooms are the perfect setting for our Differentiated Instruction approach to learning. There is a teacher and a paraprofessional in the K-4 classroom; students in grades 5 – 8 work with their classroom teacher and the Principal, who teaches social studies and serves as guidance counselor. Our “specials” (art, music, physical education, health and library) are taught once a week. Our Special Education teacher is here two days per week.

In spite of our size --- or perhaps because of it ---our students participate in a great number of classroom and extracurricular activities. The “Book It” reading program, jump rope for heart, spelling bee, science fair, winter carnival and field day are yearly events. We also take part in the Union Leader Stock Market Challenge and the Great American Mail Race. We have an active student council as well as the Kiwanis sponsored Builders Club; ski and snowboard lessons are offered to our students each winter and Lego Camp in summer.

Our full time high school faculty consists of: principal, assistant principal/athletic director, 21 teachers, nurse, librarian/media specialist, technology coordinator, technology technician, maintenance director, receptionist, executive secretary, special education teacher/case manager, five paraprofessionals, three custodians/bus drivers, and four cafeteria food workers. Over 50% of the faculty holds Master's Degrees and records of Advanced Study.

Our Guidance Department consists: director of guidance, guidance counselor, and administrative assistant. The Guidance Department works hard to meet the students' needs by helping them define and meet expectations in all aspects of their lives—personal, social, career, and educational

The school year consists of modified block schedule system with report periods every nine weeks. The standard academic course is 1/4 credit, 1/2 credit or 1 credit. Two-credit vocational courses are also offered through a collaborative vocational program with Berlin High School.

The Edward Fenn Elementary School is the home of grades kindergarten through fifth grade. Each grade level supports two classrooms. Our kindergarten functions on a ½ day program schedule. All students within each grade level experience Art, Music, Library, and Physical Education each week. In addition to these weekly specials, grades 4 and 5 also experience keyboarding classes.

The staff consists of one building principal with part-time assistant principal support, secretarial assistance, 11 classroom teachers, two Title I teachers, one special education teacher, seven paraprofessionals, one kindergarten assistant, a school nurse, a PE teacher, a music teacher, an art teacher, a librarian, a guidance counselor, and several custodians, bus drivers and cafeteria staff members. We are a staff that holds 100% "Highly Qualified" status.

We are a school that prides itself on attention to students. We maintain a system in which all staff members, students, parents and community members support partnership in education and respect for each other. We are committed to the education and positive socialization and well-being of our children.
